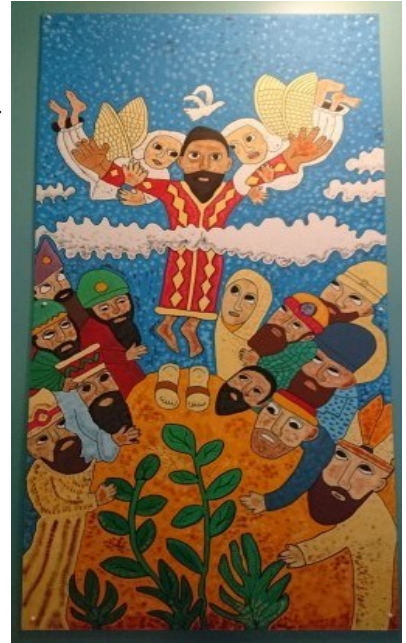
room too.
